Minutes of the March 1, 2023 meeting were approved on a motion made by Mick Regel, seconded by Victor Dodson. Motion carried.

Payment of bills: Motion by Victor Dodson, seconded by Mick Regel, to approve and pay the general account bills and accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion carried.

Patrons: Chief Thomas (LWTPD), Joann Miller, Kurvin Schrum, Karen Royer, Joe Elder, Elizabeth Kline & David Breault.

Chief Thomas passed out March's incident report and reiterated, again, to call 911 if you see anything suspicious going on...Do not put on facebook.....

Joe Elder, who lives at 137 Livia Lane, asked about having chickens...per the Borough's ordinance, (4) four chickens are permitted per acre. Since Mr. Elder's lot is a half acre, he is permitted to have (2) two chickens...

Karen Royer asked if LWT could look at the building plans...Atty. Jones said that LWT has no jurisdiction in East Prospect, but anyone can look at the plans. Also, a 'right to know' form must first be filled out.

Atty. Jones said that the York County Planning Commission, Engineer David Lipinski, and Zoning Officer Keith Hunnings currently have the plans for the Inch & Company development....The developer will be attending May's borough council meeting. At that time, any questions can be directed to the developer....

Old Business: Air-conditioning in the gymnasium....per Mick, he is still waiting for Abe Service Co. to submit the quote.

heavy, the water comes through the block into the kitchen and hallway...needs to be re-caulked or something else done...also, looking into soundproofing & installing LED lights in the gymnasium.

<u>Street Committee</u> – speed sign info passed out & copy given to LWTPD.....a new circuit board has been ordered for the flashing school sign.....the salt spreader & plow will be taken off the truck....

A new part to be installed on the street sweeper.....new signs were put up on Lemon Avenue and Vickilee Drive.

<u>Parks & Recreation Committee –</u> full schedule for baseball at ball diamond.....the pavilion project has been pushed off until August......Don will contact River Valley to do a safety check on the playground equipment.....Elizabeth Kline told Council there is a 'sharp edge' on a piece of the equipment at the playground. Yarnell Security will be contacted to set-up the camera system at the ball diamond....the recording system is currently not working....the 2022 financial report was passed out.

<u>Community Pride Committee</u> – food trucks will be at ball diamond Memorial Day.....there will be a car show July 1st, with food trucks.....working on items for the rest of 2023......the 2022 financial report was passed out......

<u>Ordinance Committee -</u> burning ordinance – Atty. Jones will write up and submit to Council for approval.

Other Business – need someone to paint all the exterior doors at the Community Hall....

Chair's Report - Don said that only (5) five people, at a time, can be in the office to review the building plans.....the pipe, at the retention pond, needs cleaned out......Don asked if council members would pick up trash, at the playground, if they see any....Don also said that, since the Borough was incorporated in 1873, some sort of celebration should be planned to celebrate 150 years as an incorporated Borough.
