ORDINANCE NO. <u>2013-</u> 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EAST PROSPECT, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE ENTRY INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH OTHER MUNICIPALITIES LOCATED WITHIN YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A REGIONAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO SERVE THE PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITIES.

WHEREAS, certain municipalities located within York County, Pennsylvania, desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement to create and provide for the operation of a regional emergency management agency to serve participating municipalities; and

WHEREAS, said municipalities, for the purpose of carrying the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act into effect, deem it appropriate to enter into such agreement; and

WHEREAS, said municipalities have determined that the residents of each municipality will be best served by a regional emergency management agency that is familiar with the challenges, services and needs of the area and who can effectively coordinate emergency services in Eastern York County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of East Prospect Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, by the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the Pennsylvania Borough Code, as amended, and pursuant to the authority and provisions of the Emergency Management Services Code, 35, Pa. C.S. 7101-7707, as amended, as follows:

<u>Section 1 – Title.</u> This Ordinance shall be known as the Eastern York County Emergency Management Agency Ordinance.

<u>Section 2 – Parties and Purpose.</u> The Borough of East Prospect, hereby resolves to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with the Townships of Hellam and Lower Windsor and the Boroughs of Hallam, Wrightsville and Yorkana, and such other municipalities as would desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement in the future, and hereby agree to create, fund and otherwise provide for the operation of a regional emergency management agency to be known as the "Eastern York County Emergency Management Agency". A copy of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 3 – Conditions of Agreement</u>. A brief summary of the conditions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement to be entered into between the participating municipalities are described as follows:

- A. The municipalities agree to create, fund and otherwise provide for the creation of the Eastern York County Emergency Management Agency.
- B. To provide for representation and governance of the Eastern York County Emergency Management Agency.
- C. To provide for submission approval and funding of the budget of the Eastern York County Emergency Management Agency.
- D. To provide for ownership of personal property and disposition of the same in the event of dissolution or withdrawal.
- E. To provide for dissolution and withdrawal by members.
- F. To provide for additional municipalities to become participating members in the Eastern York Emergency Management Agency by adopting, by Ordinance, the terms and conditions of the attached Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement.

<u>Section 4 – Repeal of Inconsistent Resolutions and Ordinances.</u> All resolutions and ordinances, or parts of either, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

<u>Section 5 – Invalidity.</u> The invalidity of any part of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance.

<u>Section 6 – Registration with County</u>. A copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the York County Emergency Management Agency and shall remain in effect unless amended. Any amendments shall also be filed with the York County emergency management coordinator.

<u>Section 7 – Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment by the elected officials of the last participating municipality to adopt this Ordinance.
