ORDINANCE NO. 2004 –8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 96-4 AND 97-3 BY INCREASING THE MINIMUM PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE DISORDERLY CONDUCT ORDINANCE (96-4) AND SNOW SHOVELING ORDINANCE (97-3) OF THE BOROUGH OF EAST PROSPECT.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of East Prospect, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. Section III of Ordinance 96-4 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section III. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, shall be imprisoned in the York County Prison for a period of not more than Sixty (60) days.

Section 2. Section 3(a) of Ordinance 97-3 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Penalties.

- a. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not more than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) plus costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the York County Prison for a term not to exceed Thirty (30) days. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
- <u>Section 3</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
 - Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
